Gray Building and associated parking garages and the curtilage of each, including the state-owned lands and public streets adjacent thereto within an area bounded by and including Calhoun Street, Pensacola Street, Monroe Street, Jefferson Street, Duval Street, Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard, Madison Street, and Gaines Street. The term shall also include the State Capital Circle Office Complex located in Leon County, Florida.
